Who Are We?

Formed in 2008, we are the first Regional Combination Fire Department in the state of Pennsylvania. We are located in York County, comprised of Springettsbury, Spring Garden, and Manchester Townships. Our highly trained and aggressive staff run approximately 5,000 calls for service yearly out of five stations. We staff five front line engines, two ladder trucks, and one heavy rescue.

What Are We Looking For?

York Area United Fire and Rescue (YAUFR) is accepting applications to develop an eligibility list for the position of Career Firefighter/EMT. We are seeking candidates who are:

- At least 18 years of age at the time of employment
- A U.S. citizen
- Possess a high school diploma (or GED)
- Possess a Pennsylvania driver's license (at the time of employment)
- In excellent physical condition
- Capable of passing pre-employment clearances
- Self-motivated
- Looking to work in a dynamic and fast-paced environment



How Do You Apply?

It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that applications are properly submitted and have been received.

Deadline for applications is 3:00pm on Friday, August 2nd 2019.

What Happens Next?

Following the receipt of applications, candidates will be notified of the time and location of a written exam. At the time of the exam, a \$40 application fee (cash or check) will be collected. Candidates who successfully complete the written test will be required to complete a physical agility test, and an oral interview.
