#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

**ROONEY** Chairman Rooney called the meeting to order. A quorum was confirmed.

#### 2. COMMUNICATION FROM CITIZENS

**BISHOP** Mr. Bishop asked about the functions of the Emergency Management Agency.

**HOFF** Chief Hoff stated the agency is composed of the YAUFR Command Staff. He noted

there is one person from the community that has expressed interest in working with them. Staff is involved in receiving EMA training at the County and State level. He noted in the past years the main focus was Three Mile Island. He indicated Staff is also trained in principals of windshield assessments, initial damage assessments, etc., to help obtain the information needed to transmit in times of flooding, snow storm or

other emergencies.

Chief Hoff indicated the work is preparedness, not necessarily response. Pre-planning of structures and/or commercial occupancies has a role in incident preparedness. Another part is maintaining the collective emergency operations plans for all three townships. It was noted that all three municipalities formed the agency in order to avoid taking action on their own. Each municipality must adopt the plan individually. Chief Hoff also noted there is a requirement for NIMS level training which all municipal leaders must attain.

Chief Hoff stated Three Mile Island is slated to come back on line in the next year or so.
